

State Lands Mapping Joint RMAC/LMAC Subcommittee

The State Lands Mapping Joint Subcommittee met to complete the review of state-owned parcels located in Sullivan County. Several of the parcels were part of or contiguous with conservation lands and wildlife management areas. The subcommittee focused on land in the Goshen and Sunapee area, with some parcels containing brooks or located along the Cold and Ashuelot Rivers.

Now that the subcommittee has assessed all the state-owned lands in Sullivan County, Michele Tremblay suggested that they convene the RMAC to demonstrate the results of their efforts thus far. Mark Hemmerlein offered to compile the data for the county and prepare a spreadsheet for the RMAC representatives to view. Michele proposed walking through the process with the representatives using some of the properties the subcommittee has already reviewed. The recommendations for the state-owned lands in Sullivan County will be put before the RMAC for adoption prior to the subcommittee continuing the review process for the remainder of the state.

NHDES staff will poll RMAC representatives to determine the most suitable date to schedule a meeting in August. The subcommittee will not meet until after the next RMAC meeting.
